


- 3 WPs recommended for funding by STFC Accelerator R&D
- In subsequent discussions: need for flexibility identified

WP1 - Generic tools for high power target development and operation

- **Task 1: Monitoring systems**
 - structural integrity
 - coolant flow integrity
 - heat transfer integrity
 - erosion/corrosion resistance integrity
 - temperature

Task 2: Studies for high Z targets

- new
- deliberately vague
- where flexibility is possible
- e.g. target limits, windows, ADS, etc


WP2 – ISIS upgrades

- gain experience relevant for ISIS



WP3 – Fluidised tungsten


Task 1: Fluidised tungsten

- Flow rig development for tungsten powder
- Heating and cooling tests
- Develop suitable diagnostics
- Pulsed proton beam test at HiRadMat facility
- Magnetic field effects
- In-beam investigation of magnetic field effects
- Identify suitable low Z powder
- Outline circuit design
- Conceptual design of Target Station







PASI Funding


- There is some flexibility!
